FEBRUARY REPORT

This month **53%** of our school either walked or rode to school. That means just over **half our school** participated in the Ride2School program. This is a great start to our school becoming more active and improving our health.

129 people walked and 19 people rode a bicycle or scooted to school.

This month's winner of the Active Traveller Award is Group 2 who had an **amazing 75% of students** walking or riding to school. This was followed closely by Group 7 who had 69% of their students travelling to school in an active way. Let's try to improve next month with an even higher active travel rate across the school. Next month there will be the **National Ride2School Day 2015.**
